Both these events are ticketed with limited numbers. The cost is \$25 which covers the cost of the music and a commemorative glass filled with wine.

We request that you do not bring your own drinks and food as everything is available here. The food is good quality and we try to offer good value. The food will be based as much as possible on local produce and please advise us of any dietary requirements. We are currently applying for a licence to supply beer so please ask how we are travelling on this one.

We provide undercover seating with tables for sun protection and in case of inclement weather. The Granite Belt is cooler and less humid than the coast but we do have the occasional hot day so please bring a hat and a jacket.

We have always run a bus at around \$10 per person return from Stanthorpe and surrounds and will also run one from Ballandean if we have sufficient numbers. The bus must be booked with us but you can choose to leave your car here and take the bus on the return trip, or we will book a taxi for you.
